The objective of the Aliant Pioneers is to promote fellowship, loyalty and service. The projects carried out by the Pioneers are very diverse and touch many groups of people. Some examples of these projects include: Computers for Schools, Keep Kiddies Warm, Heart Pillows and Hug-a-Bears to list just a few. The Aliant Pioneers also support many charities throughout Newfoundland and Labrador and on average donate \$70,000 to them every year.

The Pioneers are pleased to introduce you to the Pioneer Playday Lottery—a fun way to win cash every payday, while charities win throughout NL. There's even a Bonus Draw twice a year that participants will be entered in automatically. Here's how it works:

Put more excitement into payday!

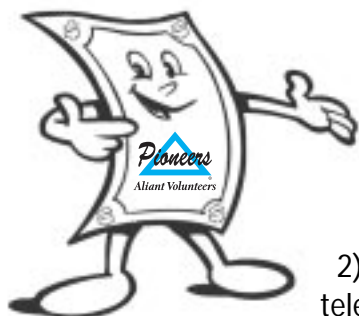
The Pioneer Playday Lottery is a 50/50 draw which you play through payroll deductions. When you join up, you decide how many tickets you would like to buy and have deducted from your paycheck on each payday. Tickets cost \$1.00 each, and you can buy up to 15 tickets on each payday. Every Friday of pay week, the winning ticket will be drawn for and the winner given a cheque the same day.

The size of the cash prize is determined by how many people are playing and how many tickets they buy:

1. 25% of the money collected is paid out to the winner on each draw date. A minimum prize of \$500 will be paid out each payday.
2. 25% of the money collected from each draw is held aside for the Playday Bonus prize, which is drawn semi-annually. All tickets purchased in paydays between the Playday Bonus draws will be entered into a draw. Approximately thousands of dollars in prizes are won in each semi-annual draw.
3. The remaining 50% of the money collected is used to fund the many worthy projects undertaken by the Aliant Pioneers. Approximately \$30,000 a year are given to charities throughout the province.



It's that simple—no lining up to buy tickets, no forgetting to play, no worrying about losing your tickets! So join in the fun and maybe your next paycheck will be a lot bigger than you were expecting.



How do I take part? Two methods:

1) To take part in the Pioneer Playday Lottery, just complete the application form below and return by interoffice mail to Payroll. Please note that a minimum of two weeks is required between receipt of your application by Payroll and the first draw you are eligible for (signified by the lottery deduction reference on your pay stub), or -

2) Send an e-mail to payroll payroll@aliant.ca giving your Name, employee #, office telephone # and the number of tickets you wish to purchase each payday. Please ensure you indicate this is for the **NL Playday Lottery**.

DETAILS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Tickets will continue to be deducted from your pay on every pay day until you give notice to change or cancel your participation in the lottery.
- All other payroll deductions take precedence over the lottery deduction.
- Lottery deductions will only be made if sufficient funds are available from your pay check. Partial deductions will not be made and deductions cannot be postponed or added to your next paycheck.
- Your pay check stub is considered to be proof of entry in the lottery. Draw tickets will be produced by the payroll system based upon your check stub number, and the number of tickets you have purchased.
- All draws will be supervised by the administrator appointed by the Pioneers.
- Tickets will be generated by the payroll system and then drawn from a drum on the Friday morning of each general pay week.
- You can join up for the Lottery at any time. To be entered in time for the next draw date, applications must be received 10 business days before the draw date.
- You can cancel your participation in the Lottery at any time by submitting a Playday Application form to Payroll. 10 business days are required to process your request.
- All persons paid through Aliant's payroll system are eligible to participate in the Pioneer Playday Lottery. This includes:
 - NL Employees and pensioners
 - Pioneers and non-Pioneers
 - On-loan employees.
 - this excludes xwave employees.
